Queensland Cerebral Palsy Register (QCPR)?

The QCPR is a large database that helps inform research into identifying **the causes, better interventions and services** for people with cerebral palsy. To produce high quality and accurate research, the QCPR needs to receive registrations from as many people with CP in Queensland as possible.

If you have contact with the families of any infants or children with a diagnosis of CP or an interim diagnosis of high risk of CP we would be very grateful for your assistance:

- 1) Please ask potential families if they are on the CP Register and request that they visit the QCPR website and register: [Queensland Cerebral Palsy Register](http://www.qcpr.org.au)
- 2) Provide families with a copy of the QCPR registration and consent forms that can be returned via post or email: [QCPR Registration Form](#) and [QCPR Consent Form](#).
